5. The length of the final submission should not exceed 2000 words, excluding footnotes or endnotes.
6. The abstract and the final submission must be typed in Times New Roman, with font size 12 and 1.5 line spacing.
7. The MLA (8) Style of Citation (latest edition) must be strictly adhered to while submitting the abstract and the final submission.

These train(s) are Rupasi Bangla Exp. (12883), Hwh Purulia Exp. (12827), Hwh Ranchi Int. Exp. (22891), Pbr. Kaviguru Exp. (12950), Samarsata Exp. (12152) etc. The minimum time a train takes to reach Purulia from Kolkata is 5h 13m. **By Road:** There are few bus services between Kolkata and Purulia from Esplanade. You can also take Bus from Durgapur to Purulia via Asansol & Raghunathpur or after getting down at Asansol you may take a taxi from Asansol to Purulia.
